



**Blood Pressure Parameters** – To ensure your patient gets their medications correctly, **DO NOT** place blood pressure parameters such as “Hold all blood pressure meds if Systolic < 100” in a **nursing communication** order. Nursing communication orders do **NOT** go to the eMAR. Place these instructions when you order the medication. See below.
